

Adjustment of Physical Education Course Requirements

(Office of Academic Affairs, Academic Planning Team / 2022.08.12.)

To provide information on the adjustment of physical education AU requirements and (draft) amendments of academic regulations upon approval by the Board of Trustees and the Ministry of Science and ICT

1 Key Changes

Type	Before change	After change
Requirement	Complete 4AU in physical education courses (2AU may be replaced with club activities)	4AU in physical education requirement abolished, 2 additional credits (freely selected) to be completed (2 credits in general, major, basic or research courses freely selected according to the student's individual study plan to be completed instead of 4AU in physical education)
Note	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • (Other course requirements) No change to existing course requirements apart from the 4AU in physical education. • (Physical education AU already obtained) For physical education AU already obtained, 1AU may be used to replace 1 freely selected credit (no change to academic transcript, physical education AU recognized as freely selected credit during graduation assessment) 	

2 Detailed Information (Students admitted in 2022 and earlier)

- (Physical education course requirements) The mandatory requirement of 4AU in physical education courses has been

removed; under the amended regulations, students are now required to complete 2 credits freely selected from general, major, basic, or research courses instead.

- No other changes were made in course requirements other than the physical education course requirements; 4AU in physical education courses are being replaced by 2 additional freely selected credits.

○ **(Physical education AU already completed)** Already completed physical education AU may be used to replace freely selected credits, with 1 AU recognized as 1 credit during graduation assessment where necessary.

※ No change to academic transcript, AU recognized as freely selected credit at graduation assessment.

< (Reference) Procedure for Physical Education AU Completion Cases (Draft) >

Type	Completion Status	Procedure (Draft)
CASE 1	Completion of 4AU or more	Graduation under previous completion requirements ※ As the academic transcript does not change and the 4AU from physical education courses are recognized as freely selected credits only for the graduation assessment, the completed AUs do not replace the freely selected credits 1 for 1.
CASE 2	Completion of 2AU	2AU recognized as freely selected credits at graduation assessment ※ No change to existing course requirements apart from the physical education 4AU requirement.
CASE 3	No AU completed	2 credits freely selected from general, major, basic, or research courses by student according to individual study plan. ※ 2 additional freely selected credits have to be completed.

3 Retroactive Application for Sports Club Activities

○ **(Basic principle)** Sports club activities may be recognized as

physical education AU credits, limited to students who have fulfilled the criteria for recognition of sports club activities but have not been able to apply for credit recognition due to COVID-19 related reasons.

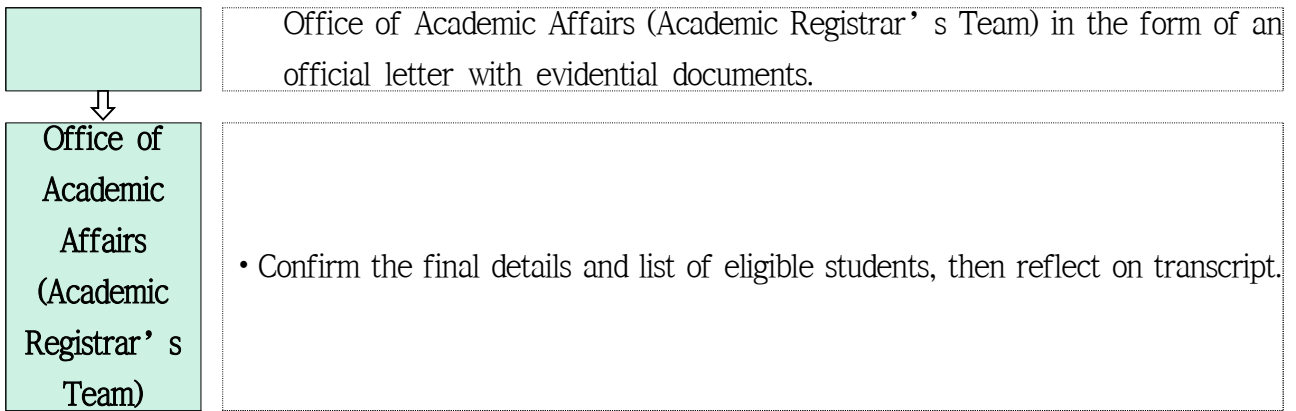
○ (Recognized cases)

Type	Years of Activity	Criteria for recognition
Recognized case 1	2018~2019 (before COVID-19)	Students who have fulfilled the sports club activity criteria for credit recognition prior to the COVID-19 pandemic, but have not been able to apply for credit recognition of sports club activities during the COVID-19 pandemic period (2020-2021) due to military service, etc.
Recognized case 2	2020~2021 (During COVID-19 pandemic)	Students who have fulfilled the sports club activity criteria for credit recognition during the COVID-19 pandemic but have not been able to apply for credit recognition.

※ Activities conducted outside of these recognized years of activity, or without eligibility for credit application already conferred are not recognized.

※ (Additional matters) No academic credit recognition for sports club activities from Fall Semester 2022 onwards.
